



## How to become an election judge Two Step Process



**Step ONE:** apply to the appropriate County or City election office which depends on where you live and where you want to work (apply on-line). We are encouraging people to sign up this year to get on the election's office list, to help in 2021 or be ready for 2022.

**Step TWO:** In 2022 confirm with the **MNGOP** that you will be an active Election Judge in 2022 by signing up via the GOP website for the SOS (Secretary of State) official list (sign up before April 1). You can also sign up at the GOP caucus on **Tues Feb. 1, 2022**. <https://mngop.com/election-integrity/>

**What else is involved?** Approximately 1-2 hours of training (on-line) after you have been cleared for employment. You will get paid. Once approved for employment they will notify you via email to schedule/confirm that you are available to work for the **primary (Aug. 9, 2022), general election, (Nov. 8, 2022) and/or for the ballot boards that start 46 days prior to election day**. Shifts are mornings, or afternoon/evening (hours specified by precinct). You may be eligible for additional compensation from your employer.
