

## Bylaws Changes Report – May 2026

Change:

### ARTICLE VIII– ~~Emergency Authority~~ Conduct of Meetings

#### Section 1. Electronic Meetings:

Excluding Conventions, Precinct Caucuses, and State Central Committee Meetings, all meetings for the Party and its local affiliates may be conducted via electronic means in which all participating members can simultaneously hear each other and have the opportunity for recognition analogous to an in-person meeting.

#### Section 2. Emergency Authority:

In the event of a declared Federal or State Emergency, all meetings and conventions for the Party and its local affiliates may be conducted via electronic means in which all participants can simultaneously hear each other and have the opportunity for recognition analogous to a regular in-person meeting. Any requirements for ballot votes may be waived, votes may be conducted via mail vote or other electronic means as determined by the meeting or convention. Other allowances for electronic meetings may be allowed elsewhere in Party documents. Any conflicting language shall defer to this rule.

Rationale:

Added language to allow for electronic meetings for any meeting other than what is specifically prohibited. Because there was no language allowing for electronic meetings, other than in emergency situations as defined in the “Emergency Authority” section the committee felt that electronic meetings were potentially not allowed.
